

Minutes of Central Indiana IMAA Chapter 48 Annual Meeting, September 19, 2009

The meeting was brought to order by president Ted Brindle.

The financial report was read and a printed copy handed out by treasurer Ron Pierce.

The treasurer's report was unanimously accepted.

The minutes of the 2008 annual meeting were read by secretary Joe Bays
and they were accepted by a show of hands.

To attract the largest attendance possible at the 2010 fly-in and at the same time maintain a good relationship with IMAA, it was agreed to apply for an IMAA event sanction and place a time limit for the "IMAA members only" portion of the Fly-in, so as to open the flying up for ALL for a fair portion of the flying day.

President Ted Brindle ask about advertisement for our 2010 annual fly-in. Ron Pierce reminded everyone that for \$55 a slightly larger ad can be purchased for Model Aviation in addition to the free one that is given with each sanction. It was noted that our fly-in would be open to all AMA members and it was agreed that the free listing in High Flight and Model Aviation were sufficient and that extra ad money need not be spent.

Ron Pierce made the motion and it was seconded and agreed by all, to limit the spending for raffle items for the 2010 annual fly-in to \$125.00. It was also agreed that the money spent and efforts made in acquiring door prizes are not necessary.

The 50/50 sales were sponsored by Madison County R/C Flyers and club member Byron Hamrick announced \$28 in sales and Tom Daily was the winner.

Raffle items included two giant scale servos and four 2008 videos of the Indianapolis Air show. President Ted Brindle was thanked for donating the videos. Rick Norris had the first winning ticket drawn and he took the two giant scale servos. Jon Fish, Butch Hedrick, Delbert Leisure Sr., and Gene Wilson appreciated winning the 2008 Indianapolis Air Show videos.

Ted Brindle declared the meeting adjourned and invited all pilot to: "Go bore holes in the sky !"
